PETITION OF
NORTHWEST REQUIREMENTS UTILITIES
TO INTERVENE TO ADD MEMBER UTILITIES AS PARTIES

Pursuant to the Federal Register Notice, 73 FR 7539 (February 8, 2008), and rule 1010.4 of Bonneville Power Administration's Procedures Governing Bonneville Power Administration Rate Hearings, 51 FR 7611 (March 5, 1986), Northwest Requirements Utilities ("NRU") submits this Petition to Intervene to Add Member Utilities as Parties in this docket.

The Federal Register Notice in this matter states that persons who previously intervened in the original WP-07 Wholesale Power Rate Adjustment Proceeding automatically continue as parties in this Supplemental Proceeding. 73 FR at 7539. NRU previously intervened on its own behalf and on behalf of individually named utility members, and therefore considers itself and these members to be parties to this docket. However, NRU's membership has changed since the original intervention. NRU therefore submits this Petition specifically to name additional members as parties and to clarify NRU's relationship with two other parties named in the original petition.

In support of its Petition, NRU states the following:

1. NRU is a non-profit corporation organized under the laws of the state of Oregon to represent the interests of its utility members in all power supply, transmission, contract, and rate matters respecting the Bonneville Power Administration ("BPA"). NRU's members are municipalities, public utility districts, peoples' utility districts, and rural electric cooperatives, all

of which are located in BPA's statutory service area. As such, these utilities are "public body and cooperative" customers of BPA and are entitled to purchase power supplies from BPA on a preferential basis pursuant to section 5(b) of the Pacific Northwest Electric Power Planning and Conservation Act. 16 U.S.C. § 839c(b).

NRU's utility members have a substantial interest in this BPA matter in this docket because they pay (and have paid) power rates that are affected by the proposal described in the February 8, 2008, Federal Register notice. The interests of NRU members are thus directly affected by the outcome of this docket, and no other party may adequately represent NRU's interests.

2. NRU's original Petition to Intervene requested that NRU and its individually named utility members be admitted as parties to this proceeding. The intervention was granted. NRU Petitions to Intervene on behalf of the following additional utility members, to add them as individually named utility parties to this proceeding: (a) City of Heyburn, (b) City of Milton-Freewater, (c) Peninsula Light, and (d) Southside Electric, Inc.

3. NRU's previous intervention identified Central Lincoln Peoples' Utility District as a utility member that should be individually named as a party to the proceeding. Central Lincoln PUD is still a member of NRU and is still a party to this Supplemental Proceeding, but may choose to represent its interests separately from NRU.

4. NRU's previous intervention also identified Springfield Utility Board as a utility member that should be an individually named party to the proceeding. Springfield Utility Board is no longer a utility member of NRU, and NRU will not represent them in this proceeding. However, Springfield is a party to this Supplemental Proceeding and therefore may represent its interests separately from NRU.
